Finance - Darren Frost

- 2022-2023 (March): \$ 148,771 in giving and \$160,160 in expenses.
- 2022-2023 (YTD): \$1,420,268 in giving and \$1,512,130 in expenses.
- Approved 2023-24 Budget: \$1,981,000.
- Average about \$10K less in giving vs contributions per month.
- Conference budget down, so our apportionments went down
