January 30, 2023

Ministry Area Reports

<u>Trustees – Robert Mooney</u>

- Trustees approved a request from Missions to enter into a partnership with Must ministries allowing Due West UMC to serve as an overflow shelter during times of extremely cold weather. A MOU was created, submitted to Must and accepted.
- Roof project was completed just in time for Christmas! There have been no additional leaks.
- The steeple had to be resealed at the base. The steeple has needed repair and the roof project caused the leak. It has been pressure washed, sealed, re stuccoed. Now waiting for dry weather so it can be painted.
- Trustees have received bids to begin the "Rose Window" project in South Campus. Work will begin in February.

Finance – Darren Frost

- 2022-2023 (December): \$161,276 in giving and \$158,043 in expenses.
- 2022-2023 (YTD): \$925,655 in giving and \$991,466 in expenses.
- Drop in giving. Hard to identify reason, but one could be the "wait and see" of some on the disaffiliation process. Another reason could be that Christmas fell on a Sunday.
- Continue to have a healthy balance in designated funds.

 - Motion was passed by majority vote.

<u>New Business – Motion 3</u>

- Request the Finance Committee to adjust the payment schedule of apportionments and hold/pause payments until the end of this year or we obtain a resolution.
 - There was discussion against this motion. Since the church has paid apportionments on a monthly basis, the concern was raised this action might send the wrong message ahead of potential litigation.
 - We decided it was important to keep our commitment to the conference.
 - The motion failed by unanimous decision.
