# **Another Holy Habit?**

If you were able to be with us during the most recent season of Lent, you heard Pastor David preach a series of sensational sermons on 'Holy Habits.' Per Pastor David, these holy habits are derived from John Wesley's 'means of grace.' John Wesley taught that God's grace is unearned and that we are not to be idle, waiting to experience grace, but we are to engage in the means of grace. The means of grace are ways God works invisibly in believers, hastening, strengthening, and confirming faith so that God's grace pervades in and through us as Christians. These means of grace, or holy habits, include prayer, Bible study, fasting, service, regular worship, and sharing our faith – all wonderful habits.

You may want to think about adding another habit: stewardship, or giving back a portion of your blessings to God. Multiple studies show that developing positive habits is good for a person's mental, emotional, and even physical well-being. Once giving back to God becomes a habit, the chances are that the giver is less likely to miss those assets, and more likely to feel engaged in the life of the local church and in Jesus Christ's mission on earth.
